Codebook for UNSC Meetings Data

The data are organized by agenda item for each year in the Security Council. The goal is to tally the number and kind of meetings conducted for each issue on the agenda if any meetings were held to discuss an issue and whether a resolution was passed. Because Security Council behaviors and reporting changes over time, it may not be possible to code every issue completely. Questions, caveats and quirks should be recorded in the notes section and brought to my attention.

Security Council meetings take various forms. Sometimes they are formal meetings open for anyone to attend. Sometimes formal meetings are closed or private. The Security Council can also hold informal consultations, which means they consult with the other members of the Council without holding a formal meeting. We need information on these three types of meetings.

Identifier Variables

Year: The year in which a particular issue appeared on the agenda.

Agenda Item: This is a description of the issue that appears on the agenda. Several issues will appear year after year, so they will show up multiple times in the dataset. Code the variables below for each issue-year, not just for each issue.

COW code: Correlates of War number identification for each issue area, as denoted "Focus Country"

Each row represents an issue-year, which is our unit of analysis. You will record information (column) for each issue year (row).

Variables of Interest

Active: Was the issue addressed in a meeting in that year? This is just a dichotomous coding 0 or 1 marking whether the issue was discussed in any meetings that year. Code '1' if it was discussed, '0' if not.

Focus Country: The isolated issue area the topic pertains to, if it can be isolated.

Topic: This is a category to help generally identify the broad subject matter or location primarily involved in the issue. Please look at the example document to guide your identification of the primary topic of the issue.

COW_US/UK/FR/RUS/CHI: Variable listing the COW code for each of the five P5 members of the UNSC.

kmdist_US/UK/FR/RUS/CHI: Lists the distance, in kilometers, from the issue area to each of the P5 members of the UNSC.

midist_US/UK/FR/RUS/CHI: Lists the distance, in miles, from the issue area to each of the P5 members of the UNSC.

Documents Referenced: This refers to specific documents—i.e. letters, reports—that appear as a second heading in the UNSC summaries. These documents show the specifics of what was discussed in meetings under broader topic names.

Focus Country: If an agenda issue is national, the focus country that is most pertinent in its discussion.

Indigenous: Binomial coding for whether or not the agenda item is indigenous to the dataset (1), or whether it was added by Eliane (0).

ISI: List of the international security institutions a given focus country was a member of during any given year.

National/Thematic: Distinguishes between the natures of agenda items. “National” denotes an agenda item that centers on a specific issue area; “Thematic” denotes an agenda item that refers to broader, thematic issues that cannot be narrowed down to one geographical location.

National: Binomial coding for whether an agenda item is “National” (1) or “Thematic” (0) (see above).

Open Formal: Record the dates the Security Council held open, formal meetings for each issue-year. So for example, if the Council met formally in an open meeting twice in 2008 to discuss Sudan, record each meeting date in this column with each date separated by a semi-colon (;). If the Council held no open, formal meetings on this issue, leave it blank.

Open #: Record the total number of open, formal meetings held in that year for the issue. Continuing with the Sudan example above, you would record 2 meetings in this column.

Closed Formal: Record the dates the Council held closed, formal meetings for each issue-year. Separate multiple dates using a semi-colon. Leave the cell blank if there were no closed, formal meetings for a given issue year.

Closed #: Record the total number of closed, formal meetings held in that year for the issue.

Doc #: UNSC document numbers from either “Documents Referenced” or from the summaries that Eliane thinks will be useful in determining what exactly the meeting discussed. They are included for later research to do be done regarding the meetings.

Informal Date: Record the dates the Security Council held informal consultations on a particular issue in a given year. Separate multiple dates using a semi-colon. Leave the cell blank if there were no informal consultations for a given issue year.

Informal #: Record the total number of informal consultations held in that year for the issue. Informal consultations generally are called 'consultations of the whole' in UN language.

Meeting #: The UNSC meeting number that refers to the specific agenda item, when available.

Notes: Notes about inconsistencies, anomalies, and/or questions added by Eliane. Also included are notes about whether or not the entry is indigenous to the dataset, or added by Eliane.

P5_ISI: Binomial coding that denotes whether or not a given focus country is a member of an ISI that a P5 country is also a member of.

Resolution: Record the resolution(s) for which a resolution is passed addressing a given issue in that year using the document number (S/RES/####). Older documents may have numbers that look a bit different. If you are unsure what number to use, just ask. Multiple resolutions should be separated by a semi-colon.

Res Date: Record the date each resolution was passed separating multiple resolution dates with a semi-colon.

Resolution Document #: Document numbers referenced in the discussion leading up to the vote on the resolution; not the actual resolution number, but the document that contains information about the resolution and voting.

Res #: Record the total number of resolutions passed in that year for the issue.

UN_only_member: Denotes whether or not the given focus country is only a UN member (1) or if it belongs to other ISI's (0).

Include a row that counts how many meetings of each kind you could not match to an agenda item for each year.
